## Professional Journey

STEFF CHELARU WAS BORN IN BOTOȘANI, ON DECEMBER 7, 1992. She holds both a Master's and a Bachelor's degree in Fashion - Art Studies from the National University of Arts, Bucharest, as well as a Bachelor's degree in Scenography from the National University of Theatre and Film Arts.

### 2025

The year concluded with the opening of the first private theatre in Romania after 60 years—namely TEATRUL GRIVIȚA 53—with the production “5+3=9”, directed by Ștefan Lupu. At the beginning of the year, a premiere took place in Iași with “There Is a Lady at the Door Asking for the Gentleman”, based on the original text “Fazanul” by Georges Feydeau, directed by Cristi Avram at the Iași National Athenaeum. The second premiere of 2025 was staged in collaboration with director Vlad Massaci, with the production “Ordinary People” by David Lindsay-Abaire, at the “Andrei Mureșanu” Theatre in Sfântu Gheorghe. The third production was “Morphine” by Mikhail Bulgakov, directed by Dumitru Acriș, at the “Elvira Godeanu” Dramatic Theatre in Târgu Jiu. In September, rehearsals began for the premiere of “Marriage”, based on the play by Nikolai Gogol, directed by Mihai Brătilă, at the “Elvira Godeanu” Dramatic Theatre. The month of November concluded with the premiere of “The Star Without a Name” by Mihail Sebastian, directed by Cristi Avram, at the “Elvira Godeanu” Dramatic Theatre.

### 2024

IN 2024, she premiered Farfuria by Maria Manolescu, directed by Dragoș Mușoiu, as part of the Bucharest Scenography Biennale at Masca Theatre. She designed the set for The Memory of Water by Shelagh Stephenson, directed by Mihai Brătilă, at “Elvira Godeanu” Dramatic Theatre in Târgu-Jiu, and for The Beast by Raluca Mănescu and Denisa Nicolae at Metropolis Theatre, Bucharest. Returning to her hometown, Botoșani, she worked with Andrei Măjeri on Pieces of Resistance. She also served as assistant scenographer for Robert Icke's Mary Stuart, directed by Andrei Șerban, under stage designers Helmut Stürmer and Corina Grămășteanu.

### 2023

IN 2023, she created scenography for several premieres. The most recent was at the German State Theatre in Timișoara, in collaboration with the Jewish Theatre of Bucharest: Sisyphos. A Stand-up Tragedy by Thomas Perle, directed by Clements Bechtel. At Andrei Mureșanu Theatre in Sfântu Gheorghe, she designed the set for Sakura Sandwich by Doru Vatavului, directed by Tirsza Kovacs, and also the costumes for How We Met, Bought a House, and Found Happiness in Orlando, based on Chuck Palahniuk's story, directed by Vlad Massaci. She further collaborated with Andrei Măjeri on Medea (Ben Power's modern adaptation) at Mic Theatre, Bucharest. Later that year, she joined the Power Lab project residency at Metropolis Theatre, where her project Aquatic Ballerinas by David Drabek received recognition alongside scenographer Monica Stoica.
